

Pack trip –Checklist

The following is a list of suggested items for you to wear or carry in your duffel or saddlebag for a six-day pack trip. We provide both the duffel and saddlebag. There is a **20 pound limit** for the duffel bag (which will be carried by a pack animal) and includes your sleeping bag, but not your sleeping pad. The saddlebags will be tied to the back of your saddle where you will have access to any item in it during the ride in and out of camp. **We encourage you to bring unscented, biodegradable and environmentally friendly toiletry products.**

Duffel Bag

- Camp shoes (sneakers)
- Waterproof shoes
- Lightweight sleeping bag (+5 to 0 degree rating, you will be warm)
- Inflatable open cell sleeping pad-full body length (Thermarest type)
- Two (2) long-sleeved shirts
- Two (2) short-sleeved shirts
- One (1) heavy sweater or down vest
- One (1) change of pants
- Five (5) pairs of socks/underwear
- One (1) set of thermal underwear (not cotton)
- Bathing suit
- Towel and toiletries
- Personal flasks and goodies (No Breakable Bottles)
- Reading, writing or drawing materials
- Gaiters are great for early mornings, as the grass can be quite dewy

Saddle Bags

- Camera, batteries, film or card
- Hat with sun protecting brim
- Gloves
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen/chap stick
- Polarized sunglasses
- Jack knife or multi-use tool
- Pepper Spray (optional but recommended)
- Binoculars
- Headlight and extra batteries
- Toiletries that are breakable (use a zip lock bag)
- Moist towelettes
- optional *Personal water filter, straw or bottle top type or hydration pack (Camelback type)

Items lashed to your saddle

____ Winter jacket, rain pants and rain jacket or long riding “Dusters” (NO Ponchos!)

*Lunch and water bottle provided

*Sleeping pad will be packed with the camp gear, not in you duffel.

*Any fishing rods must be in hard cases.

*Please think about usefulness and lightweight when packing.

** This checklist was designed for a six day pack trip.
